Whenever Jesus prayed, He always had a plan. He had things on His heart that He wanted to pray for and knew how He wanted to pray for them.

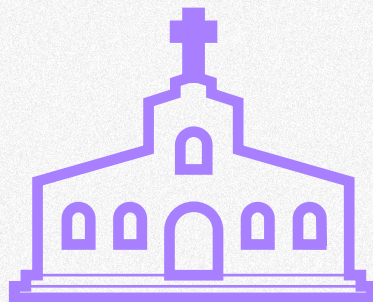
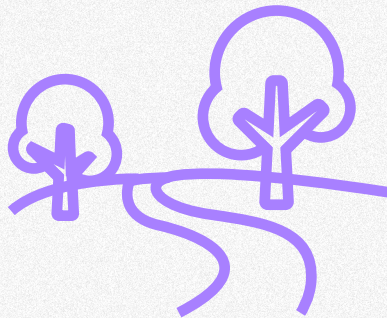

**One day Jesus was praying in a certain place. When He finished, one of His disciples said to Him, “Lord, teach us to pray..”**



LUKE 11:1

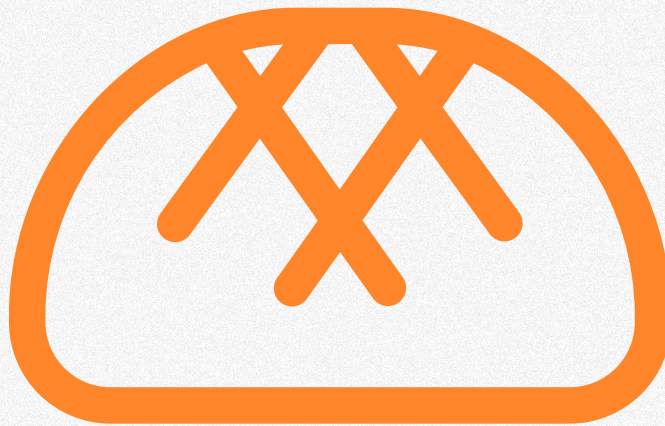






## 4. “...Give us this day our daily bread...”

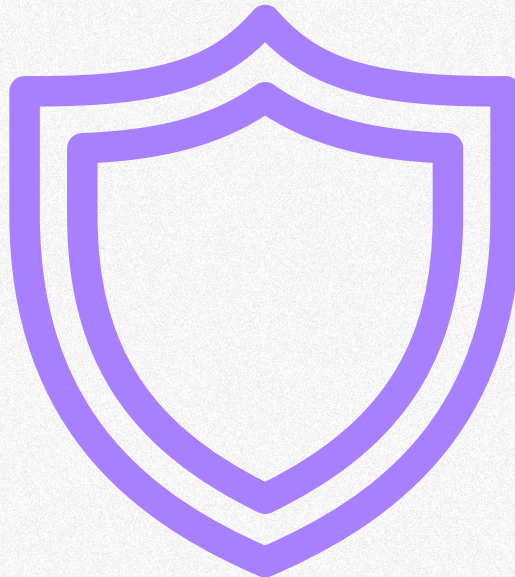
**Ask Jesus to look inside your heart:**

and I am never alone.

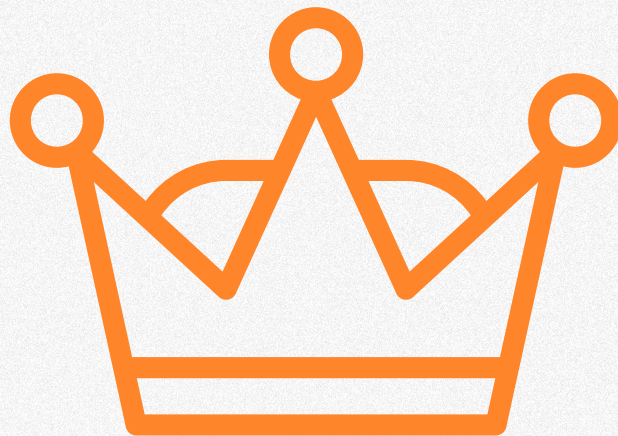
I can tell the truth
